LASERS to Present Pension System Update at Baton Rouge RSEA Meeting

Baton Rouge – Cindy Rougeou, Executive Director of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System (LASERS), will speak to the Baton Rouge chapter of RSEA on Thursday, March 16, 9:30 a.m., at the BREC Womack Building, 6201 Florida Blvd., Baton Rouge. Active state employees and retirees from Ascension, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberville, Livingston, Point Coupee, West Baton Rouge, and West Feliciana parishes are expected to attend.

Rougeou will address current issues affecting state employees and retirees' pension benefits, including the upcoming 2017 Regular Legislative Session. Rougeou will be available for interviews before and after the presentation. RSEA members will also be available for interviews.

In the Baton Rouge RSEA chapter region, 14,331 LASERS retirees and beneficiaries received more than \$381 million in gross retirement benefits in fiscal year 2016.

LASERS administers a defined benefit pension plan that covers approximately 100,000 members. *LASERS Benefits Louisiana* by paying over \$1 billion in annual benefits to beneficiaries, providing a strong and reliable economic stimulus for the state.
