#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Overall, the LDOJ has effective procedures in place with regard to the handling of retirement related processes for their LASERS members. No agency issues were identified during this review.

#### **BACKGROUND**

This was a planned engagement on the fiscal year end 2015 Audit Plan. The fieldwork for this engagement was completed on June 23, 2015.

The Louisiana Attorney General heads the Department of Justice and serves as the chief legal officer for the state. The mission for LDOJ is to protect the people and resources of the State of Louisiana by providing superior legal representation, and interpretation, professional and effective law enforcement, and public education programs.

LDOJ employs approximately 460 LASERS members.
