LASERS to Present Pension System Update at Lake Charles RSEA Meeting

Baton Rouge – Cindy Rougeou, Executive Director of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System (LASERS), will speak to the Lake Charles chapter of RSEA on Tuesday, March 13, 9:30 a.m., at the SOWELA Technical Community College, Arts & Humanities Building, 3820 Sen. J. Bennett Johnston Avenue. Active state employees and retirees from Allen, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, and Jefferson Davis parishes are expected to attend.

Rougeou will address current issues affecting state employees and retirees' pension benefits, including a new retirement plan for future state employees proposed in the upcoming 2018 Regular Legislative Session. Rougeou will be available for interviews before and after the presentation. RSEA members will also be available for interviews.

In the Lake Charles RSEA chapter region, 1,831 LASERS retirees and beneficiaries received more than \$40 million in gross retirement benefits in fiscal year 2017.

LASERS administers a defined benefit pension plan that covers approximately 100,000 members. *LASERS Benefits Louisiana* by paying over \$1 billion in annual benefits to beneficiaries, providing a strong and reliable economic stimulus for the state.
