





 LASERS emails include timely information such as legislative updates, upcoming events and important reminders.




IRS Form 1099-R

- Available by the end of January, annually
 - Form mailed to address on file
 - Form is accessible in your online account
- Retirees may receive more than one IRS Form 1099-R:
 Distributors from Pensions, Annuities, Retirement or Profit Sharing Plans, with different codes in Box 7 titled
 Distribution Codes.
- Definition of Distribution Codes:
 - Code 2: Benefit payments received <u>before</u> age 59 ½ are classified as early distributions.
 - Code 7: Benefit payments received <u>after</u> age 59 ½ are classified as normal distributions.



IRS Form 1095-C

- Form 1095-C: Employer Provided Health Insurance Offer and Coverage required by the IRS
- LASERS does not have access to this form
- Retirees should contact:
 - Your last employed agency, or
 - The Office of State Uniform Payroll at 225.219.9434



Direct Deposit

 Financial institution account changes <u>cannot</u> be taken over the phone by LASERS representatives or through Member Self-Service.

Two Options:

- Submit Form 04-05: Authorization for Direct Deposit*
- Submit a letter including your Social Security number, account number, routing number and signature*



^{*}Must be received by close of business on the 13th of the month to be effective the 1st of the following month.


Change of Address

- Keep your mailing address current!
- Address changes cannot be done by calling LASERS
- Change your address via:
 - Member Self-Service
 - Submit Form 1-02: Change of Address



Income Verifications

- Can be created from Member Self-Service, or
- Contact LASERS by phone and request (will be mailed to address on file)
- Submit a written request or complete Form MSD32: Request for Contribution / Income Verification located on the LASERS website
 - Processed within 10 business days
 - Cannot fax or mail to alternate address without a written request



Self-Directed Plan

- DROP and IBO participants may find out information on the Self-Directed Plan (SDP) on the LASERS website.
 - The SDP is administered by EMPOWER Retirement.

No State Tax Due On Your Pension

• You do not owe **Louisiana** state income tax on your LASERS pension.

Contact your tax advisor with your tax questions.



Change of Retirement Option

There are only two ways to change Options 1-4B:

- Death of a Beneficiary can change to Maximum.
 - Request increased payments by submitting Form 10-07: Application for Change in Retirement Benefit due to Death of Beneficiary
 - Submit copy of beneficiary's death certificate
 - Effective date will be based on date of beneficiary death



- Submit Form 10-06: Application for Change in Retirement Benefit due to Divorce
- Submit certified true court order stating former spouse irrevocably relinquishes the survivor benefits under the option selected
- \$150 actuarial fee



Disability Retirees

If you retired under Disability Retirement, you may have the option to convert Disability Retirement to Regular Retirement on the date you meet regular retirement eligibility.

- Disability retirees who retired out-of-state service must convert to regular retirement age.
- Disability retirees who retired in-state service have the option to convert to **Regular Retirement**.
- LASERS will notify disability retiree by mail approximately **six months prior** to the date the retiree would be eligible for Regular Retirement with the options available.



Re-employed Retirees

Retiree hired in a LASERS-eligible position must select one of four options:

OPTION 1A

50% Earnings Limitation

- Receive monthly benefit
- Earn wages of 50% or less of annual benefit
- Fiscal year earnings limit
- No contributions paid to LASERS
- If earnings limit exceeded, will owe LASERS the amount of excess earnings
- Retiree responsible for monitoring earnings

OPTION 1B

- No earnings limit
- No benefit suspension
- Must have retired with 30 years or more
- Must be at least age 70

OPTION 2*

Regain LASERS Membership

- Repay all benefits received since retired plus interest at actuarial rate
- Service credit restored as if you had not retired
- Become an active member of LASERS and employee & employer contributions resume

*DROP, IBO, and Early Retirement retirees cannot choose this option.

The 20 years at any age actuarially reduced retirement is not an early retirement.

OPTION 3


Suspension of Benefit

- Retirement Benefit suspended
- Employee and employer contributions resume
- No earnings limit
- Work less than 36 months, contributions refunded when separate, benefit resumes
- Work 36 months or more, supplemental benefit is added to retirement benefit
