LASERS to Present Pension System Update at Monroe RSEA Meeting

Baton Rouge – Cindy Rougeou, Executive Director of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System (LASERS), will speak to the Monroe chapter of RSEA on Wednesday March 4, 9:00 a.m., at the Delta Community College, 7500 Millhaven Rd., Monroe. Active state employees and retirees from Caldwell, East and West Carroll, Franklin, Jackson, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, and Union parishes are expected to attend.

Rougeou will address current issues affecting state employees and retirees' pension benefits, including the upcoming 2020 Regular Legislative Session. Rougeou will be available for interviews before and after the presentation. RSEA members will also be available for interviews.

In the Monroe RSEA chapter region, 3,779 LASERS retirees and beneficiaries received more than \$84 million in gross retirement benefits in fiscal year 2019.

LASERS administers a defined benefit pension plan that covers approximately 100,000 members. *LASERS Benefits Louisiana* by paying over \$1 billion in annual benefits to beneficiaries, providing a strong and reliable economic stimulus for the state.
