

**ANNUAL REPORT ON PROPOSED RULE ADOPTION,
AMENDMENT AND REPEAL FOR
CALENDAR YEAR 2018
Department of the Treasury
Board of Trustees of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System**

A. During calendar year 2018, the Department of the Treasury, Board of Trustees of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System ("LASERS") proposed the following adoption, amendment, and repeal of its rules:

1. Amendment in part and repeal in part of provisions contained in Chapters 11, 17 and 25 of Part I of LAC Title 58. Repeal of §1101(B)(2) occurred because it referred to a group insurance plan that is no longer administered by the Louisiana Workforce Commission. Section 1107(D) was amended to allow case-by-case exceptions to the requirement that vendors submit only one deduction file per month. Section 1115 was amended to remove the requirement that vendors report changes in company status or principal officers. Sections 1707, 2505, 2507, 2509, 2511 and 2519 were repealed in their entirety because they were redundant and simply repeated provisions found in statutory law.

The amended rules became effective December 20, 2018.

B. During calendar year 2018, the Department of the Treasury, Board of Trustees of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System ("LASERS") took no action with respect to any fee adoption, increase or decrease.
