EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

No reportable issues were identified during this review.

BACKGROUND

This was a planned engagement on the fiscal year end (FYE) 2022 Audit Plan. The fieldwork for this engagement was completed on March 10, 2022. The DVA employs approximately 650 LASERS members.

SCOPE, OBJECTIVES, AND METHODOLOGY

The scope of this engagement included a review of records for the DVA employees.

The primary objectives of this engagement were to determine if the DVA:

- Accurately reports payroll, earnings, and contribution information to LASERS.
- Accurately and timely enrolls eligible individuals into LASERS.
- Performs retirement and post retirement processing in an accurate and timely manner.

Procedures used to complete this engagement included:

- Reviewing relevant personnel and payroll records.
- Reviewing records from the State of Louisiana Retirement Information System (SOLARIS).

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
